SEMINAR OVERVIEW

SECTION 1

After explaining some realities of college athletics, the program starts by helping athletes and parents understand how to narrow down colleges. This is done based on academic standing, personal desires (e.g. distance from home, school size, etc.) At this stage we don't consider athletics—college is about getting an education, not just playing sports. Should an athlete get hurt, cut, or quit playing, we want them to be at a school they like.

SECTION 2

Participants learn ways to evaluate athletic talent, and determine how this relates to college levels. For example, should an athlete determine him- or herself to be a Division II player, then he or she should target high Division III, Division II, and low Division I schools from Section 1. Thus, we get a list of colleges that are perfect for all factors, not just sports.

SECTION 3

Student-athletes learn to create a marketing package that includes letters, video, or other materials introducing them to the targeted coaches. Participants then learn how to follow up with coaches in order to foster and gauge interest and scholarship potential.

SECTION 4

Participants learn how to evaluate the programs that are of interest to them, and will review recruiting rules, official visits, academic eligibility, and how to register for the NCAA Clearinghouse.

SECTION 5

Student-athletes learn how to evaluate offers and make a final decision. The seminar concludes with information about preparing students for life in college.
